# **Appeasement**

Neville Chamberlain and Adolf Hitter shake hands at the Munich Carference in 1938. This resulted in the pact, signed 29 Sept, which recognized the German amexation of the Sudetenland in Czechoslovakia in return for a promise that there would be no further aggression. This policy of appeasement failed to prevent the outbreak of World War II.
